**TEMPORARY MARRIAGE LICENSE OFFICE OPENS FOR  
VALENTINE'S DAY PEAK**

**(LITTLE ROCK, ARK.)** – The Pulaski County Circuit and County Clerk's Office will open a temporary marriage license office one block west of the Pulaski County Courthouse at 501 West Markham Street on Friday, February 12 to help couples obtain their marriage licenses faster and easier during this traditionally high peak time before Valentine's Day.

"Love is still in the air even with a pandemic," Circuit and County Clerk Terri Hollingsworth said. "Valentine's Day is on a Sunday this year and despite the many limitations posed by the pandemic, we are thrilled to offer a safe, more convenient way for couples to get their marriage license and have a little fun while doing it."

The temporary "pop-up" office is located on the south end of the Pulaski County Regional Center. Street parking is available along West 2nd Street by Enterprise Rent-a-Car. Couples entering the building using the North Broadway Street entrance will enjoy taking photos at the "selfie station," listening to traditional wedding music and receiving Valentine treats all while applying for their marriage license.

Public access to the Pulaski County Courthouse is still restricted to limit public exposure to Covid-19. The temporary office is large enough for couples to social distance and wearing a face mask is required. The office will be open from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will be the only site to issue marriage licenses that day and will accept credit card or cash payments only. Marriage licenses cost \$60 and both parties must be present and together when the marriage license is issued.

Couples are encouraged to fill out a marriage license form before arrival, which can be found through the County website at [www.pulaskiclerk.com](http://www.pulaskiclerk.com) and be prepared to show a valid photo identification, such as a driver's license, passport or military ID. Anyone seeking to be married on Friday can contact one of the Pulaski County Justice of the Peace directly. A complete list can also be found on the County website.
