Little Rock to Host White House Community Confidence Tour

WHAT:

A press conference will be held as part of the White House's Community Confidence Tour visiting Little Rock. The day-long visit will include roundtable discussions, a pediatric vaccine clinic and informal meetings with parents, teachers, and community leaders to discuss the impacts of COVID-19 from a health equity perspective and how the pandemic has impacted community violence.

There will be b-roll and sound opportunities at the vaccine clinic immediately following the press conference. Vaccine doses will be provided and administered by the Arkansas Department of Health Office of Health Equity and Kavanaugh Pharmacy.
