Markham St. in Little Rock, AR.

Judge LaTonya Honorable, Judge Cara Connors, Judge Melanie Martin, and Judge Rita Bailey of the Pulaski County Circuit and District Courts will hear cases for individuals who appear on this date. Attendees can benefit from the following services: waiving or reducing unpaid court fines and fees; recalling child support, misdemeanor and felony financial obligation warrants; recalling misdemeanor first FTA warrants; and reinstating driver's licenses for eligible cases. All matters will be addressed on a case by case basis¹. The following resources will also be available: voter registration and voter restoration for felons; re-entry resources including employment, housing, GED, and technical training opportunities; as well as information on criminal record sealing.

Various community organizations, including the City of Little Rock Department of Community Programs, Goodwill Industries of Arkansas, Sistas-in-Law, Shorter College, Center for Arkansas Legal Services and many others, are partnering in this event to provide valuable support and additional resources to attendees. Come on out WITHOUT THE FEAR OF GOING TO JAIL for unpaid fines, fees, or child support.
